

BYLAW NO. 1986-2

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE DESTRUCTION OF GRASSHOPPERS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315 of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:

"crop year" means the period from April 15th to September 15th of the same year;

"department" means the Department of Agriculture for the Province of Saskatchewan;

"municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315;

"owner" includes every person who owns, occupies or controls land within the municipality.

2. Every owner of land within the municipality shall take the following measures for the control and destruction of grasshopper during the current crop year:

(a) he shall be responsible for controlling grasshoppers within the area lying between the centre line of the road allowance adjoining the land and the nearest boundary of the land owned, occupied or controlled by him in the municipality; and he shall apply poison on these infested areas in the manner recommended by the department.

(b) he shall apply a poison to control grasshoppers to all of his land within the municipality and infested with these pests, including fields, trap strips, pastures, yards, waste places, fence lines and other such, and in a manner recommended by the department.
