APPENDIX "A" TO BYLAW NO. 1989-4

1. That the parties to this agreement form a Mutual Aid Area.
2. That each party to the agreement will assist any other party to the agreement in the event of a disaster.
3. That each member municipality shall appoint one member of Council to represent the municipality.
4. That the municipal councillors shall act as the Control Committee who shall annually;
  - a) elect from the Control Committee, one person to act as Chairman;
  - b) appoint a recording secretary for the purpose of recording minutes and circulating correspondence; and
  - c) appoint a mutually agreed upon Mutual Aid Area E.M.O. Co-ordinator.
5. That the Control Committee shall determine the Emergency Response Centre Headquarters location.
6. That the objective of the Mutual Aid Area is to establish a unified, effective organization involving neighbouring communities to lend reciprocal assistance, expertise and equipment in time of disaster and that this objective can be met by:
  - a) Establishing and maintaining a modern and effective communications system, including training, to ensure a co-ordinated response to any disaster within the Mutual Aid Area.
  - b) Preparing and maintaining a current list of manpower and equipment available in each municipality.
  - c) Developing a Mutual Aid Area plan to effectively use the resources of manpower and equipment available throughout the area.
  - d) Long-term planning by the Control Committee to utilize the Joint Emergency Planning Program to improve the emergency response capability of the Area.
7. That each party to this agreement recognizes that there is no financial commitment involved, unless they, through the Control Committee, decide otherwise.
8. That a municipality not wishing to participate in providing pertinent share of funding to obtain mutually beneficial equipment specifically obtained for disaster emergency response shall not be bound to do so, however, may be charged a fee for the use thereof in the event it is required, and said fees shall be determined by the Control Committee.
9. That this agreement be continuous; however, any party to this agreement may withdraw from the agreement by giving each other party to the agreement sixty (60) days notice of such withdrawal.
