

BYLAW NO. 2005-7

A BYLAW TO LICENCE MINING CONTRACTORS, OIL AND GAS WELL OPERATORS

The Council of the R.M. of Montrose No. 315 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Mining contractors, oil and gas well operators engaged in the operation of potash, oil or gas well drilling within this municipality shall obtain a licence from the administrator of the municipality before commencing such operations and shall pay in advance the following licence fee:
 - (a) for the drilling of an oil well or a gas well \$450.00
 - (b) for the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information \$225.00.
2. The full licence fee mentioned herein shall be payable regardless of the date of issue of any licence.
3. For the purpose of this Bylaw, the word "contractor" and "operator" shall include any person, firm or corporation.
4. Any contractor or operator holding a licence under this Bylaw shall produce and exhibit the licence when required to do so by the licence inspector, police officer or other authorized persons.
5. Any contractor or operator found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this Bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
6. Bylaw No. 1986-4 is hereby repealed.
