


Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315

Bylaw No. 2018-6

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2016-12 known as the Zoning Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts this bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 2016-12 as follows:

1. The Zoning District Map referred to in Section 7 is amended by rezoning from A-Agriculture District to AR-Agriculture Residential District the lands legally described as LSD 9 and LSD 16, located in the NE ¼ Section 24-33-08-W3M as shown within the bold dashed line on the map attached as Schedule "A" which forms part of this bylaw.
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when approved by the Minister of Government Relations.

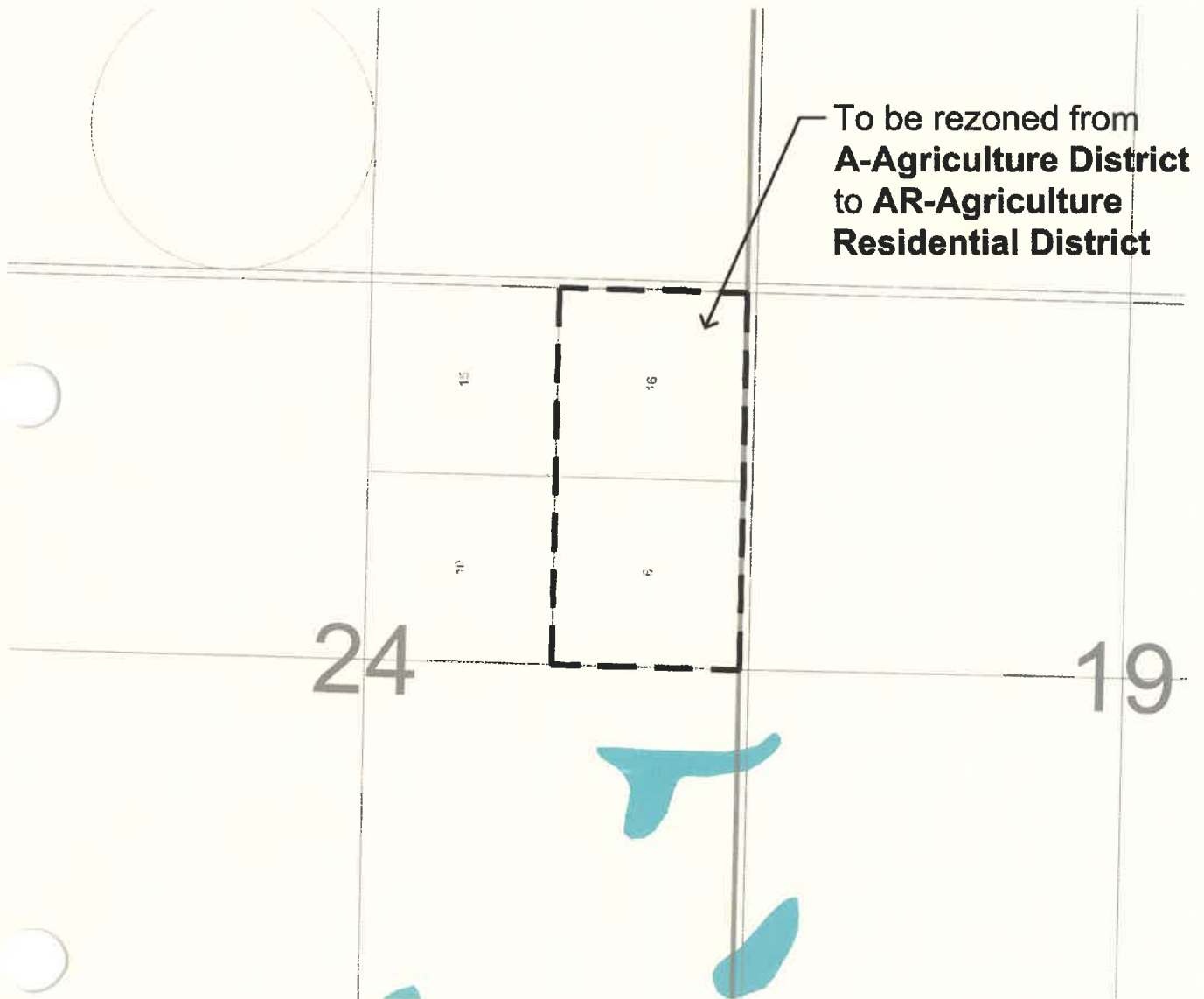
