
BYLAW NO. 2019-08

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Montrose No. 315.
3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. Every person who contravenes any provisions of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
5. That Bylaw 1990-1 is hereby repealed.
